

## Marta Brunelli - Curriculum Vitae

After graduating in the Arts-Classical Curriculum at the University "La Sapienza" in Rome (highest marks: 110/110 cum Laude), she specialised with Post-graduate Courses in: General and Museum Didactics (University of "Roma Tre", 1997/'98); Management and Direction of Libraries (Catholic University of Sacred Heart in Milan, 1998/'99); Management and Conservation of Rare Collections (University of Siena, Arezzo Branch, 1999/2000); Adult Education (University of "Roma Tre", 2003/'04, in quality of auditor). From 1997 to 2003 she applied herself to the management of cultural and library services, management of historical archives and rare books' collections. During the PhD in "Models of education. Theory and Comparison" (Department of Education of the University of Calabria) she explored the role of the public library in the framework of the lifelong learning. After the post-doctoral Grant in history of education (University of Macerata), since April 2008 she has been a Junior Researcher in General and Social Pedagogy (M-PED/01), and aggregate Professor for the chair of Heritage Education at the Faculty of Cultural Heritage in Fermo (University Branch of Macerata).

**Research fields.** The history of the book as a vehicle of education, from the early modern to the contemporary era between persistence and development of educational models; the social and educational role of cultural institutions such as libraries, museums and archives: analysis of cultural structures' educational services (for children, adults, aged, families, groups, etc.), and theoretical reflection on the informal learning processes and museum and library learning models.

**Research projects.** At present she takes part in the inter-university Italian project *Dipesi* (Dictionary of pedagogists, educators and children's writers) within the research group of the University of Macerata. She took part in the following European projects: *History on Line* (Life Long Learning Programme - Erasmus EVC programme, 2007-2009), as member of the research unit of the University of Macerata; in quality of counsellor of the IAL Nazionale she worked in the project *Biblioformeda (Leonardo Programme, 2003/04)*, focused on the role of the librarian facilitator in lifelong learning; she participated in *Eu-Lis - Lis Education in Europe* (Socrates Programme, 2005), as member of the international workshop "[The library in the multicultural information society](#)".
