

Paolo Bianchini is research fellow at the University of Turin. He made his PhD in History of the European Society in Modern History under the direction of Luciano Guerri and Daniel Roche. Since 2001 he is lecturer of History of Education and Welfare Institutions at the University of Turin. He is Vice-president and coordinator of the Course for Professional Educators and representative of his Faculty at the Centre for the History of Turin University (CSSUT). He is coordinator of the Italian data-base on textbooks *Edisco*. His main topics are history of education and culture between 18th and 20th centuries and history of school manuals.
